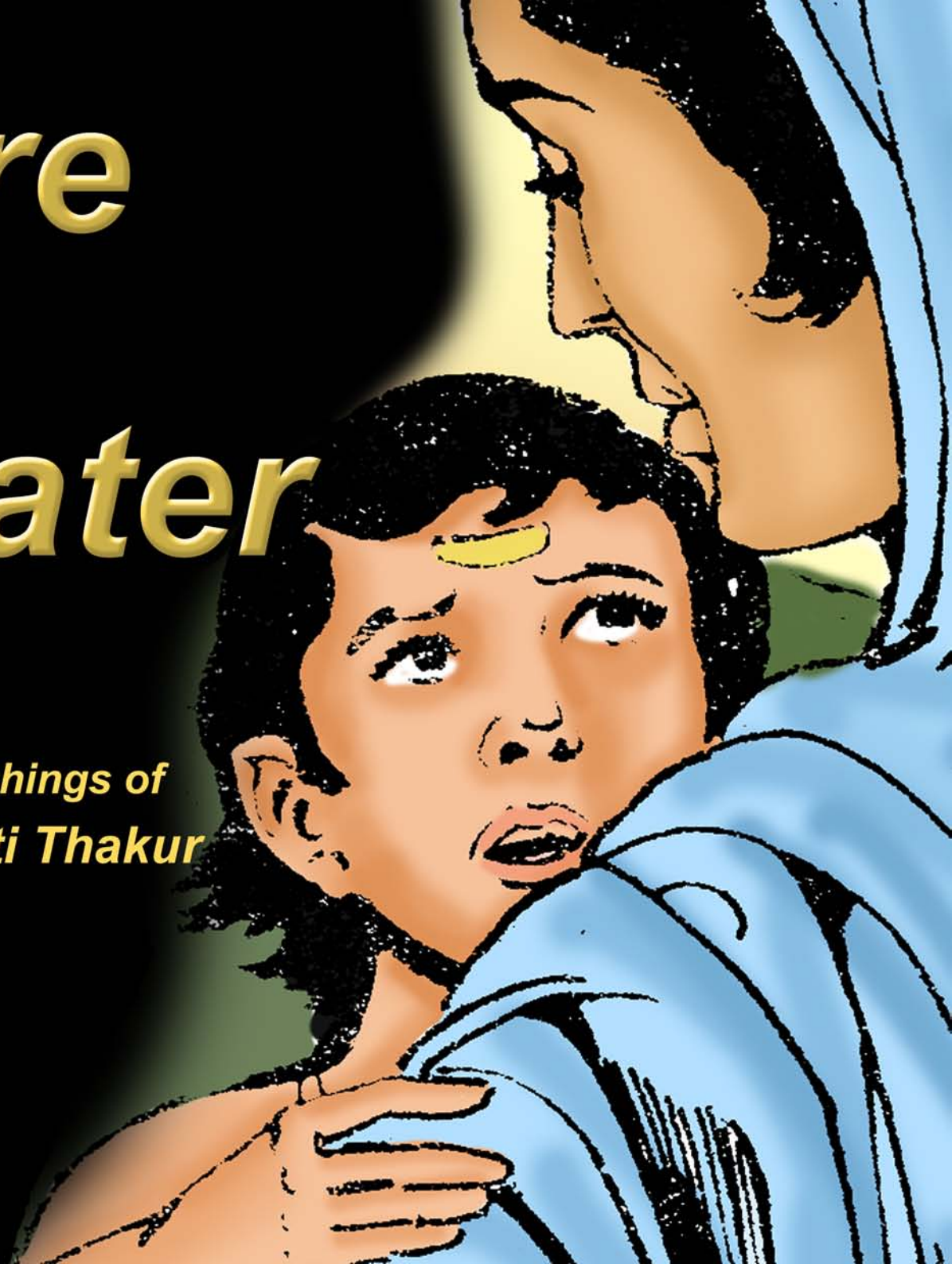


The desire to swim out of water

PURPORT
