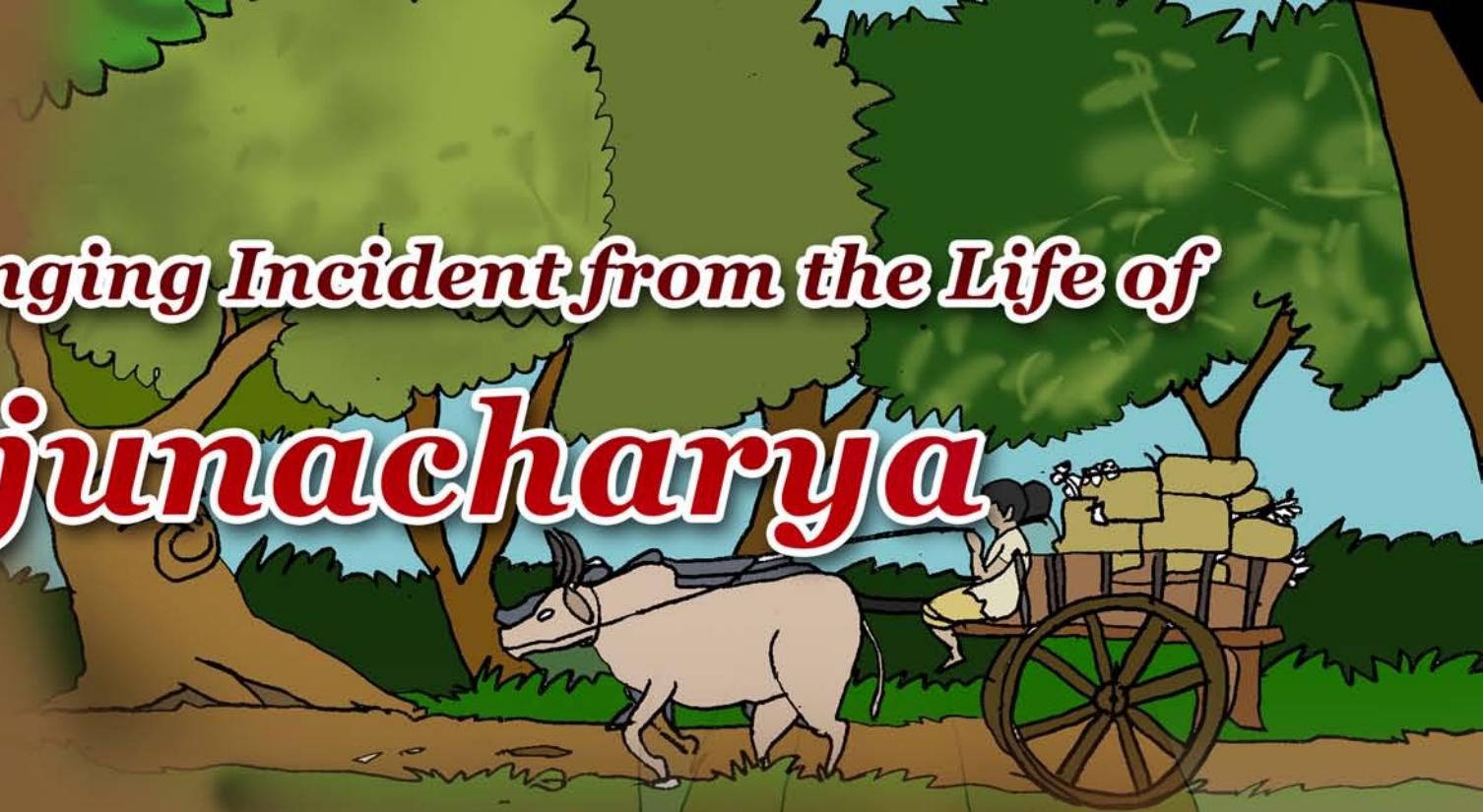



A Life-Changing Incident from the Life of
