I will be benefited.**






But when he was on his death bed, at the last minute he had a change of heart.

**But unfortunately the old man died before his servant returned.**







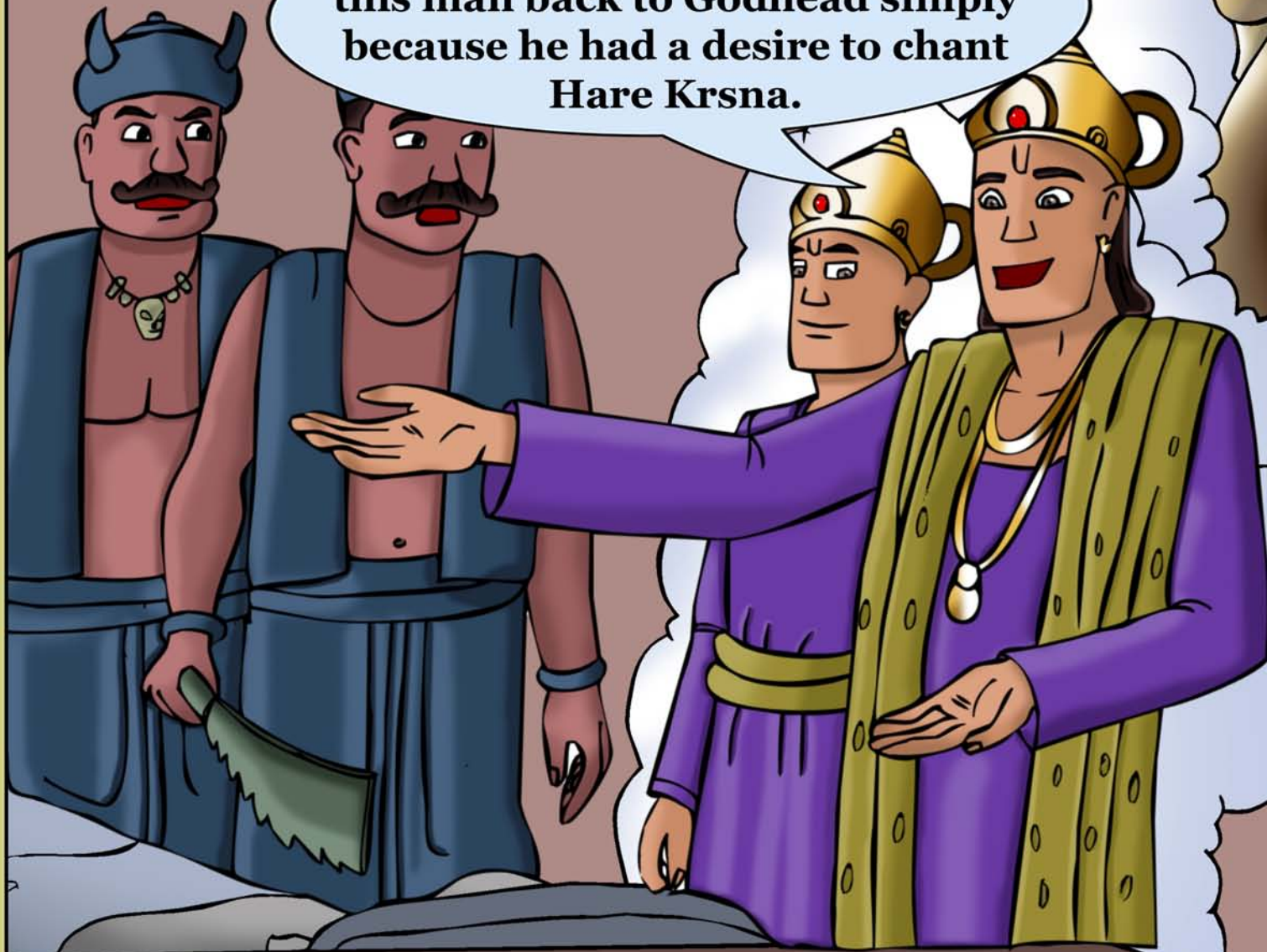
**So at that time the Yama-dutas came, and the Vishnu-dutas also came at the same time. Both parties questioned each other's presence.**
