An axe was once talking to a tree...

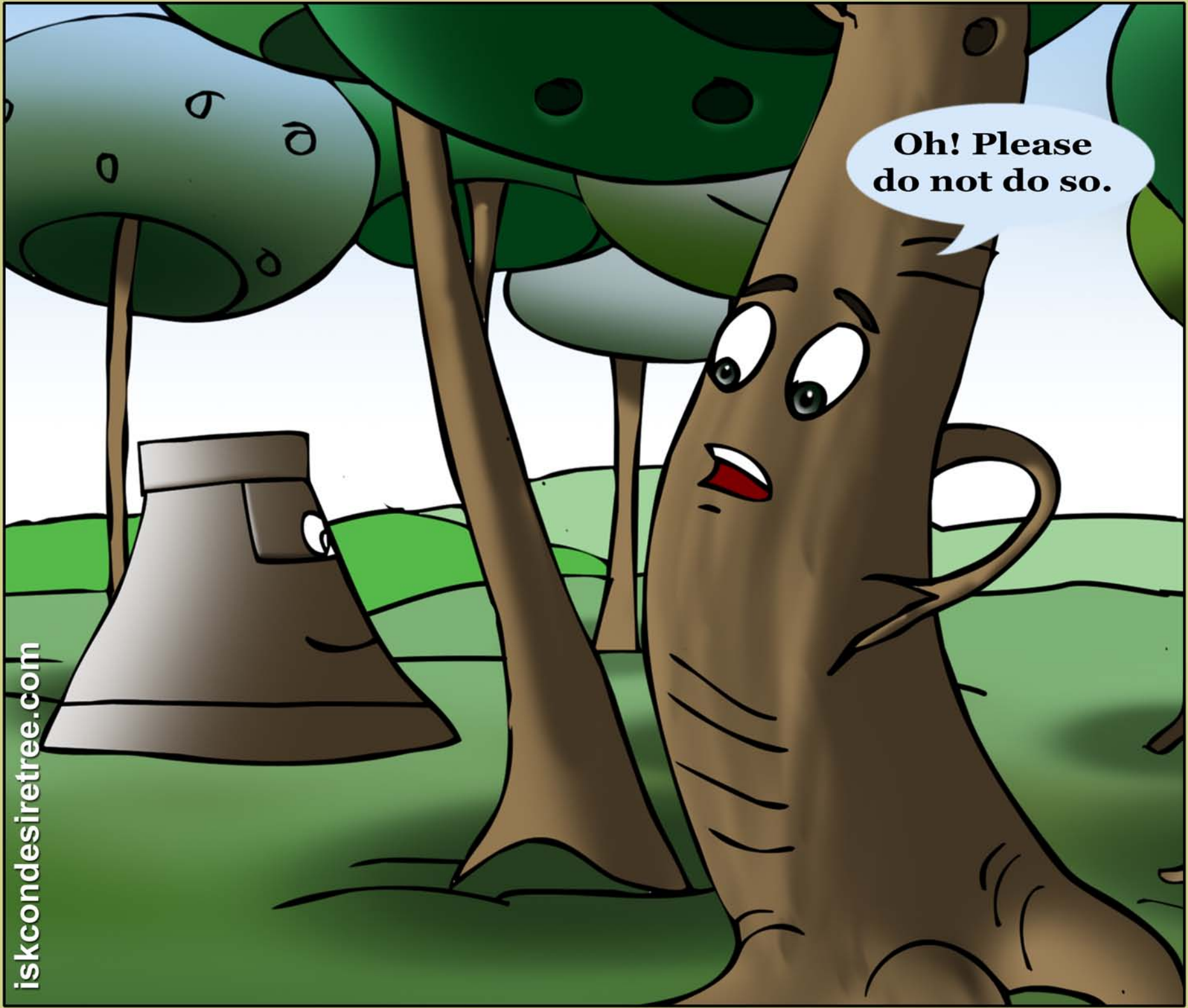


**I am

down to pieces.**

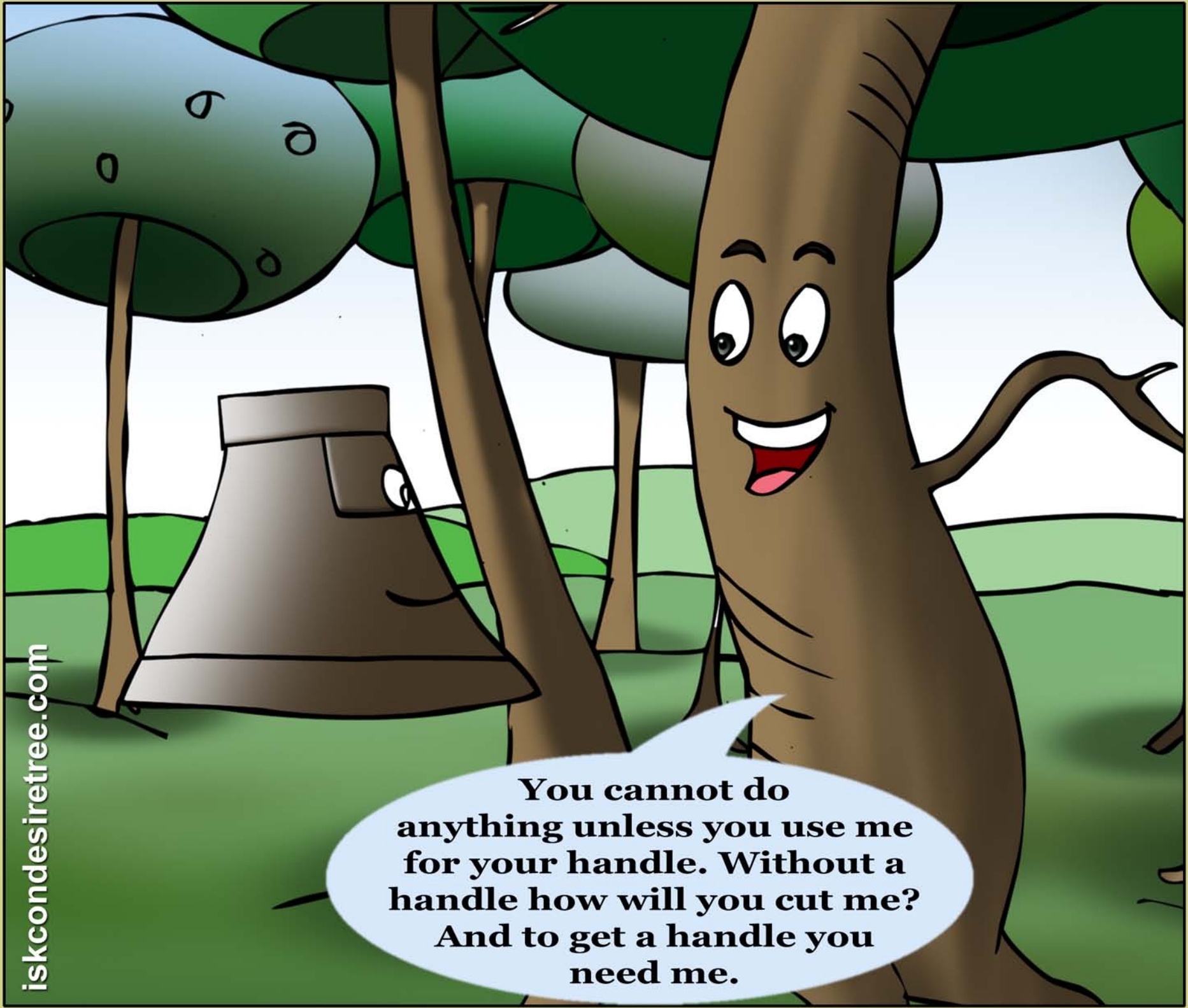




**Oh! Please
