

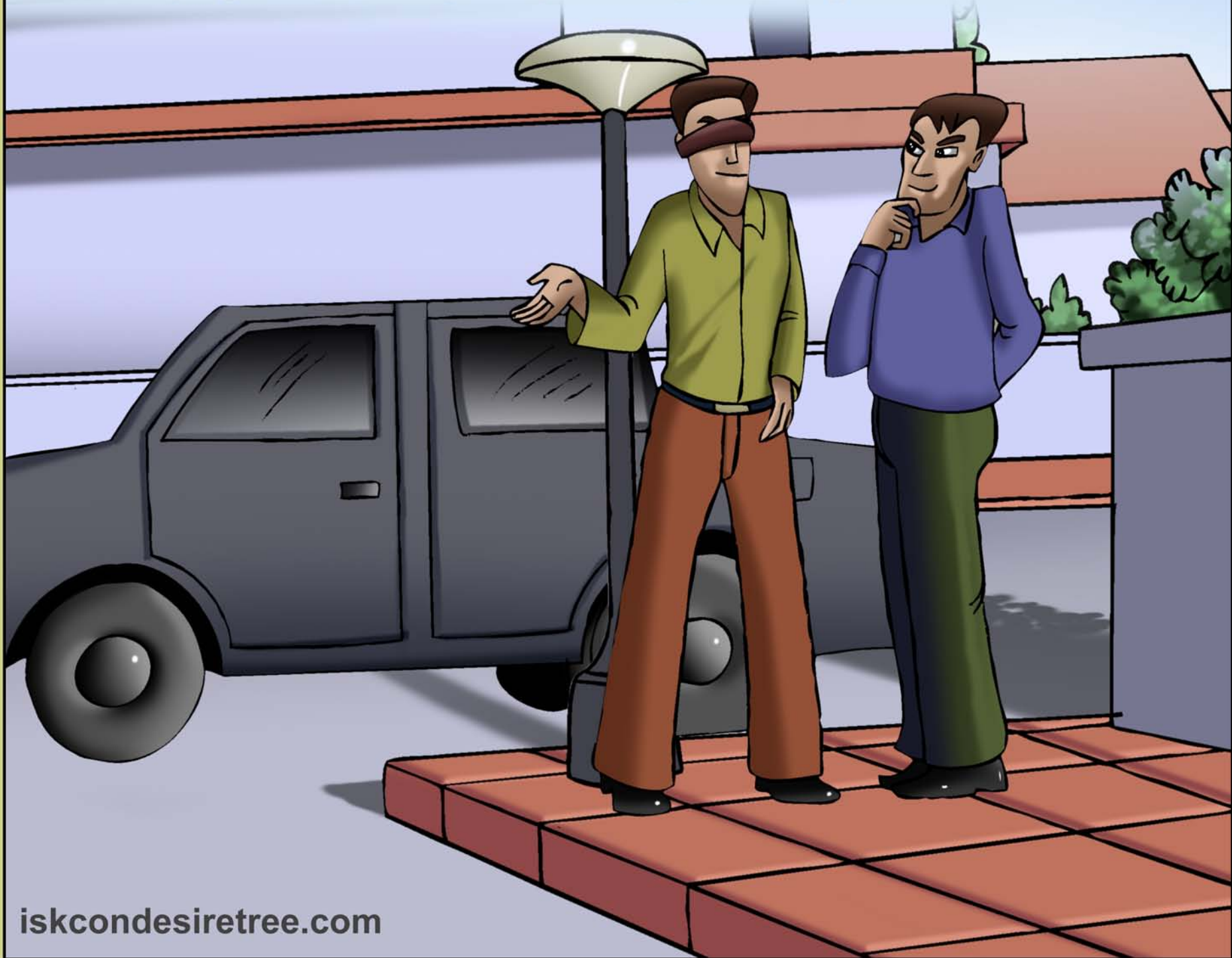
The Blindfolded Man

That's an Ambassador car.



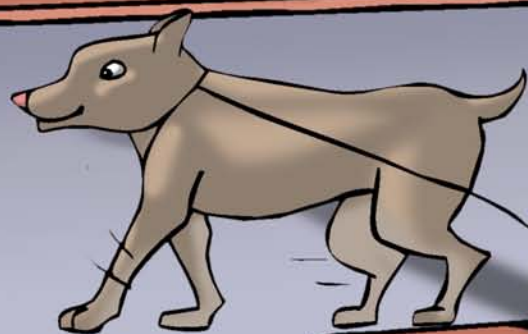


That's a Fiat car.
