At that time Gopal was passing by Govinda's house and one of the pots hit him.

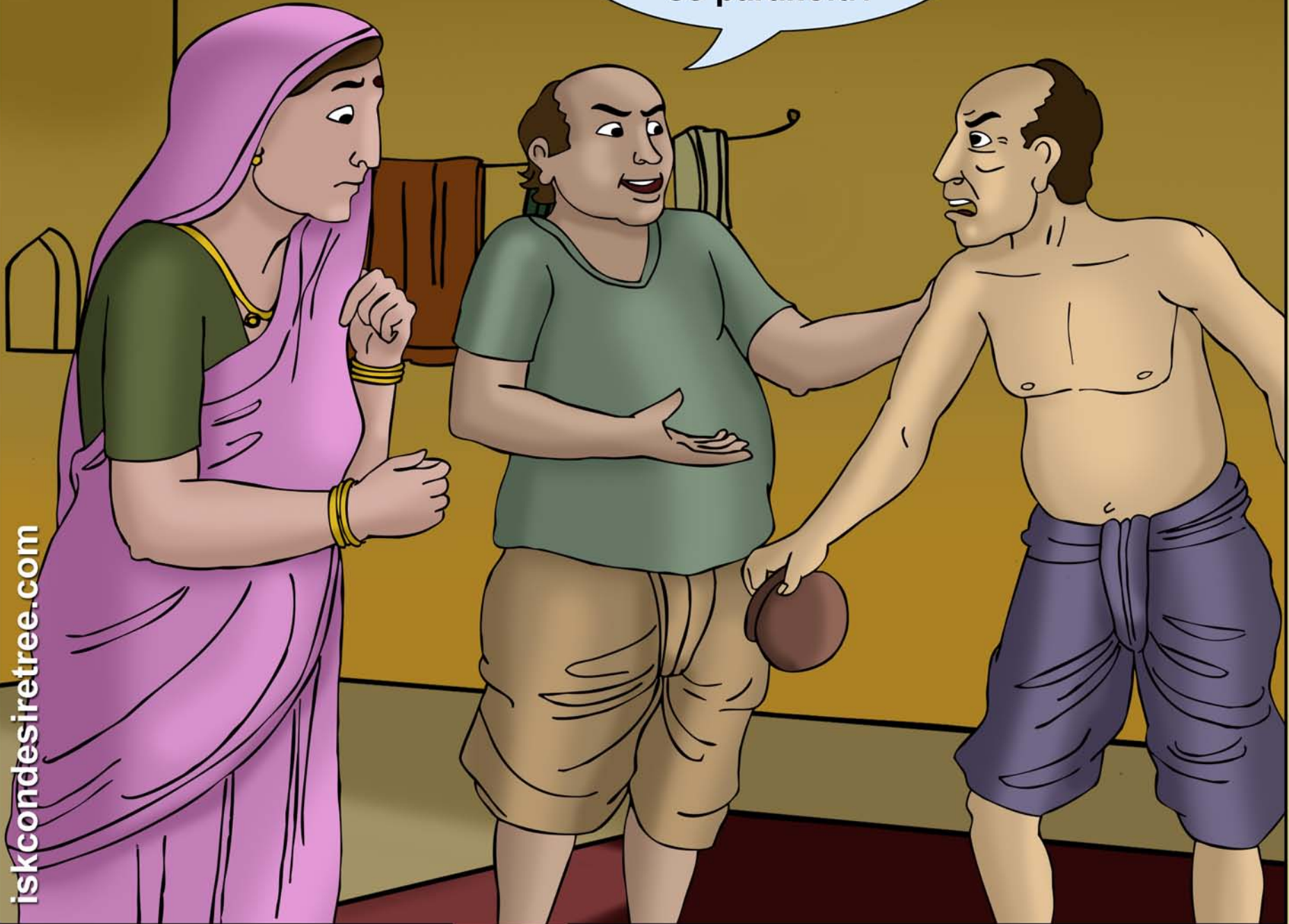


Gopal immediately rushed inside the house and found that Govinda was about to hit his wife with a pot.

Why are you beating me?

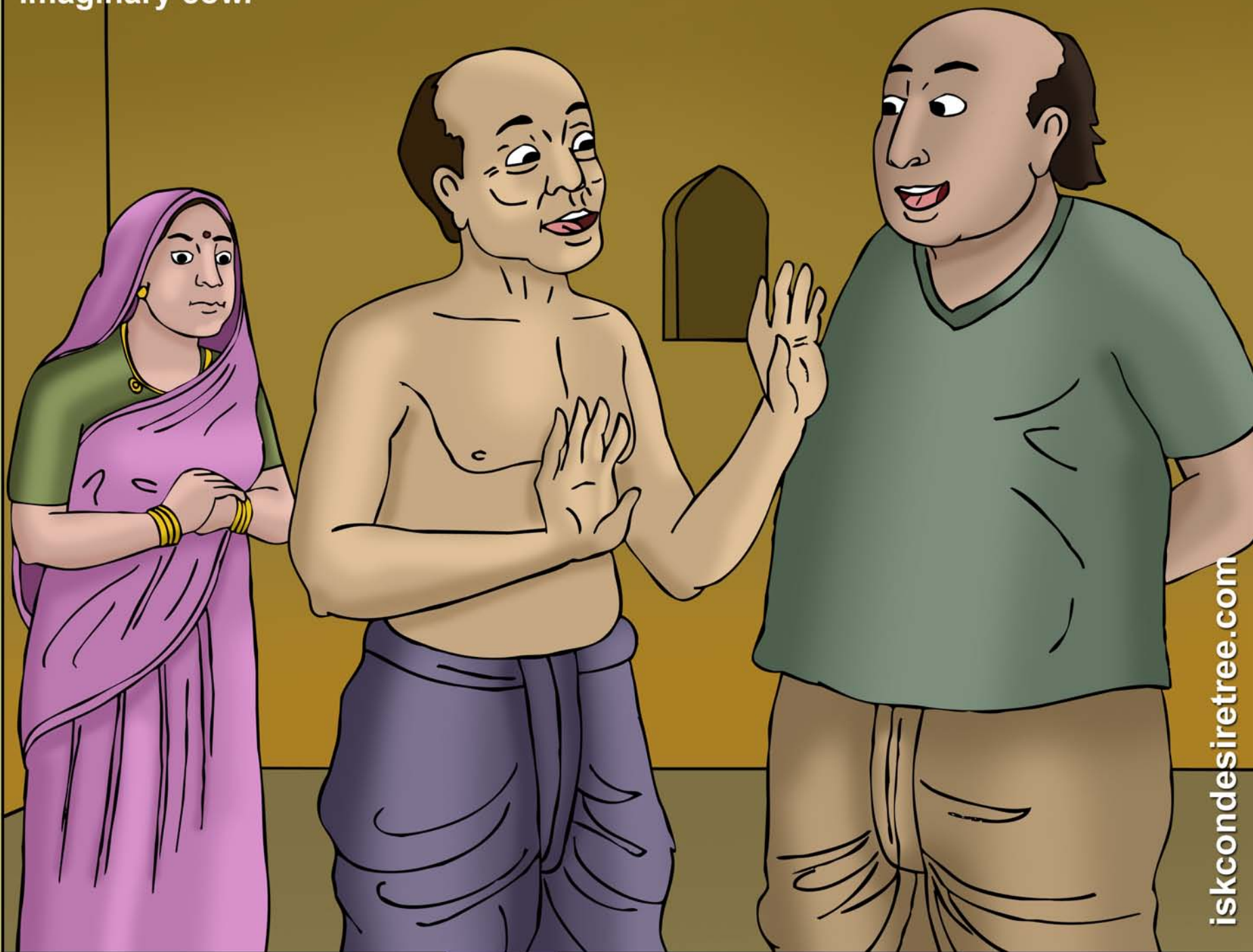




Because your cow entered into my field and destroyed it totally.
