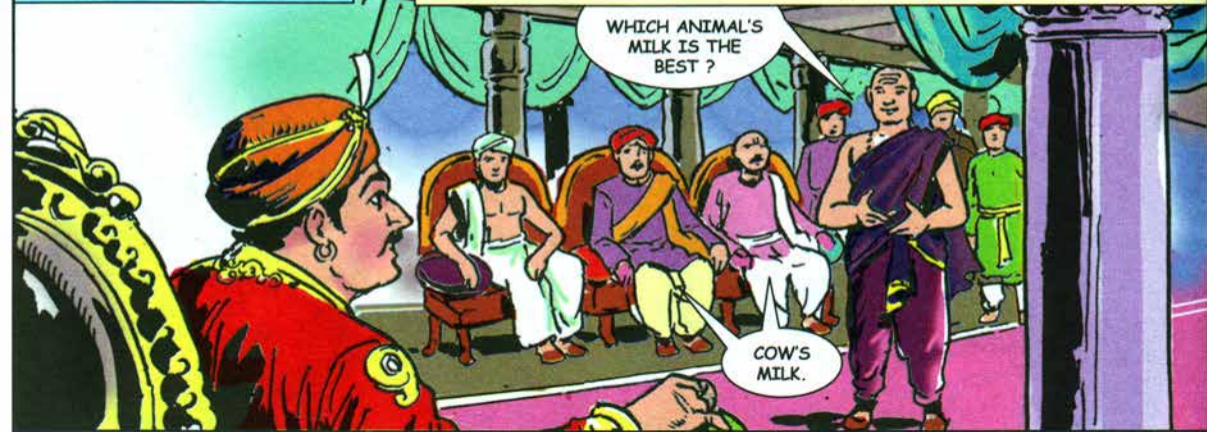


## 2. TENALIRĀMA

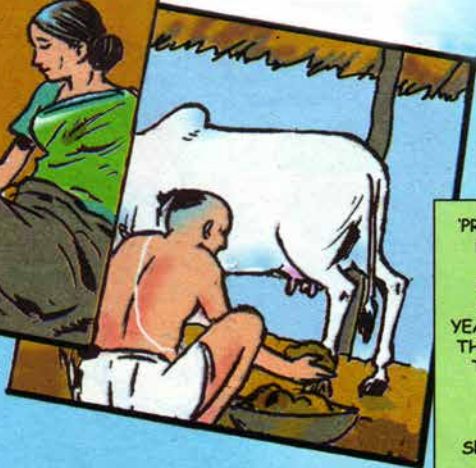
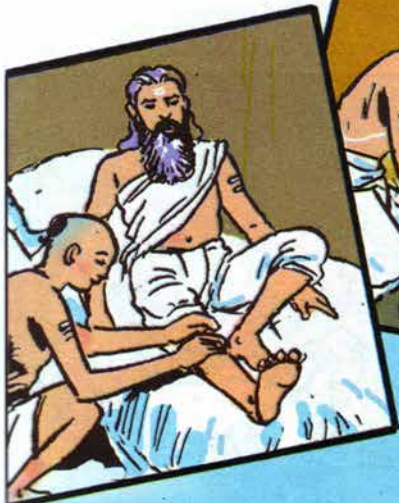
